**Free Immunization Clinics for Grades 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>**

In 2009, the Indiana State Legislature revised the Indiana code to require all 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade public, charter or private school students to receive additional immunizations against the following diseases:

- Meningitis
- Varicella (Chicken pox)
- Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (Whooping cough))

Students must be vaccinated against all three by the first day of the 2010 school year. To assist families with immunizing their children and to better accommodate the large number of students in 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades, the Grant County Health Department will be offering these vaccines during extended hours at the Five Points Mall. The free vaccines will be given in the Community Room during various times from now through the beginning of school. You may also choose to schedule an appointment with your family Physician. We believe if we begin to immunize now; we will minimize the chaos in August!

Our Schedule in the Community Room at the Five Points Mall will be as follows:

- April 7<sup>th</sup> - 3:00 to 7:00 PM
- May 5<sup>th</sup> - 3:00 to 7:00 PM
- June 9<sup>th</sup> - 1:00 to 6:00 PM
- July 14<sup>th</sup> - 1:00 to 6:00 PM
- July 28<sup>th</sup> - 1:00 to 6:00 PM
- August 4<sup>th</sup> - 1:00 to 6:00 PM
- August 5<sup>th</sup> - 1:00 to 6:00 PM
- August 6<sup>th</sup> - 1:00 to 6:00 PM

**Parents will need to bring their child's shot record and child must be accompanied by parent or legal guardian.**
